 - **Construction of a New 730 meter Precision Rifle Range to the Northwest corner of our property. Includes a New firing line. Estimated cost of \$150K. We have contractors available to complete the Earthworks in October 2021. A General Membership Vote is required to approve this spend prior to further Construction.**
 - **Renovations and repairs of the Indoor Range- in progress. We are looking for an insulation Contractor that can insulate the Filtration /Recirculation Ducting. Also looking to blow in an additional R-20 of Attic Fill over most of the ceiling.**
 - **Trap Range Upgrades- Trap house #3 has been re-fitted and upgraded including a new Hi Capacity "Pat Trap" and a roll up security door. We are installing a Target Tag control system that will allow Self-Serve Trap up to 7 days a week. Trap house #2 will be upgraded with a new door and Target Tag system as well. This will use pre-paid cards that can be user re-charged much like a Timmy's Card. The card Kiosk will be going in at Rocky's General Store. A big thanks to Theresa and Terry for making room for it.**
 - **A new lamp post and LED yard light with motion sensor will be installed at the new Gate.**
 - **New shooting benches are being fabricated for the 100 meter range.**
 - **Noxious Knapweed has been found on our property. We have missed the growth window in 2021, so it has been deferred until 2022.**

- Thanks to Emcon for the use of their wheel loader and to the guys who worked on berm /back-stop repairs thru the Labour Day weekend!
- Replacement of the Clubhouse front doors with industrial steel slabs and frames. Waiting on another quote.
- Gates to replace the chains at range vehicle access points. Looking at proposals and cost estimates.
- Food Safe training. Anyone who will be handling food on behalf of the Club should have Food Safe. The Club will sponsor the training for volunteers who will be involved with our various events.
